



















#### GLASS BOTTLE DECORATION-SECTION A & B








#### LIPPAN ART - SECTION C & D

#### LE CHÔMAGE

Le Chômage peut être défini comme l'inactivité d'une personne souhaitant travailler. Cette définition du chômage connaît de nombreuses variantes et son concept donne toujours lieu à des controverses théoriques et statistiques. Le chômage a été considéré comme résiduel et volontaire jusqu'au début du  $20^{\mbox{eme}}$  siècle. Maintenant il est devenu un des problèmes sociaux et économiques les plus centraux des pays développés.

Longtemps les femmes sans emploi ne se considéraient pas comme chômeuses mais simplement « non payées ». Aujourd'hui, leur réaction est relativement semblable à celle des hommes. Elles refusent souvent le statut de « femme au foyer » et la perte des liens sociaux qui dépendaient de l'exercice de leur profession. Avec l'apparition des familles monoparentales elles peuvent vivre des situations de désastre économique et de culpabilité vis-à-vis du foyer dont elles ont la charge.

La France est le pays où le taux de chômage est le plus bas de l'Union européenne. Le taux de chômage en France a reculé de 2,16% au mois de mai 2006, ce qui équivaut à 48900 chômeurs de moins. Ce bon résultat qui est le troisième meilleur depuis 25 ans, est attribué aux effets du plan de cohésion sociale et au développement des services à la personne.

L'ANPE (Agence Nationale pour l'Emploi) a été créée à Paris le 13 juillet 1967, en ayant pour mission d'aider et de conseiller aux personnes à la recherche d'un emploi ou d'une formation, mais également d'aider les employeurs pour l'embauche et le reclassement des salaires.

Depuis 1995, elle s'est ouverte à l'Europe, en partenariat avec d'autres pays membres de l'union européenne. Tout récemment, les jeunes de moins de 26 ans ont leur propre espace sur le site internet de l'ANPE « pole emploi.fr. » afin de pouvoir les accompagner dans leur démarche de recherche d'un premier emploi ou bien trouver un job pour l'été.
