- ❖ **Maintaining a regular bedtime and wake-up time** , this can help children stay healthy and avoid excessive screen time.
- ❖ **Encourage children to try new activities** like painting, playing an instrument, or learning a new skill.
- ❖ **Involve children in household chores-** assign age-appropriate tasks to teach responsibility and teamwork.
- ❖ **Prepare meals together, experiment with different cuisines, and learn about different cultures.**
- ❖ **Plan family outings-** go to amusement parks, movie theaters, or other fun places together. Play indoor or outdoor games together. Plan a trip to a new place or revisit a favourite destination. Document your summer memories together.
- ❖ **Encourage the child to speak simple sentences in English. Motivate the child to use polite words** such as 'Please', 'Thank You', 'Sorry', 'May I'.
- ❖ **Spend more time with grandparents and talk to them. Listen to their old stories which show their love and affection for us. Their experience teaches us a lot.**
- ❖ **Give back to the community and teach children the importance of helping others.**



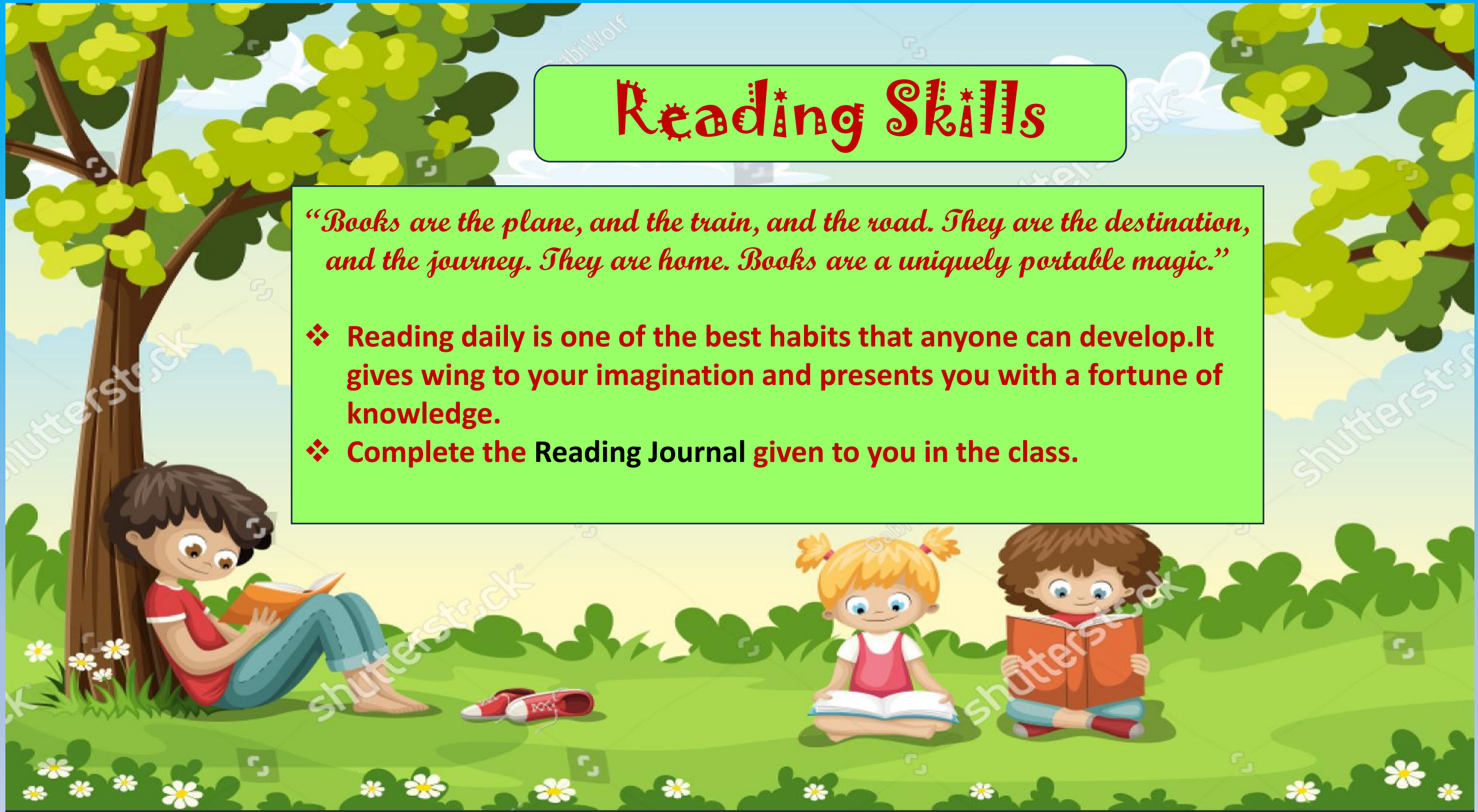

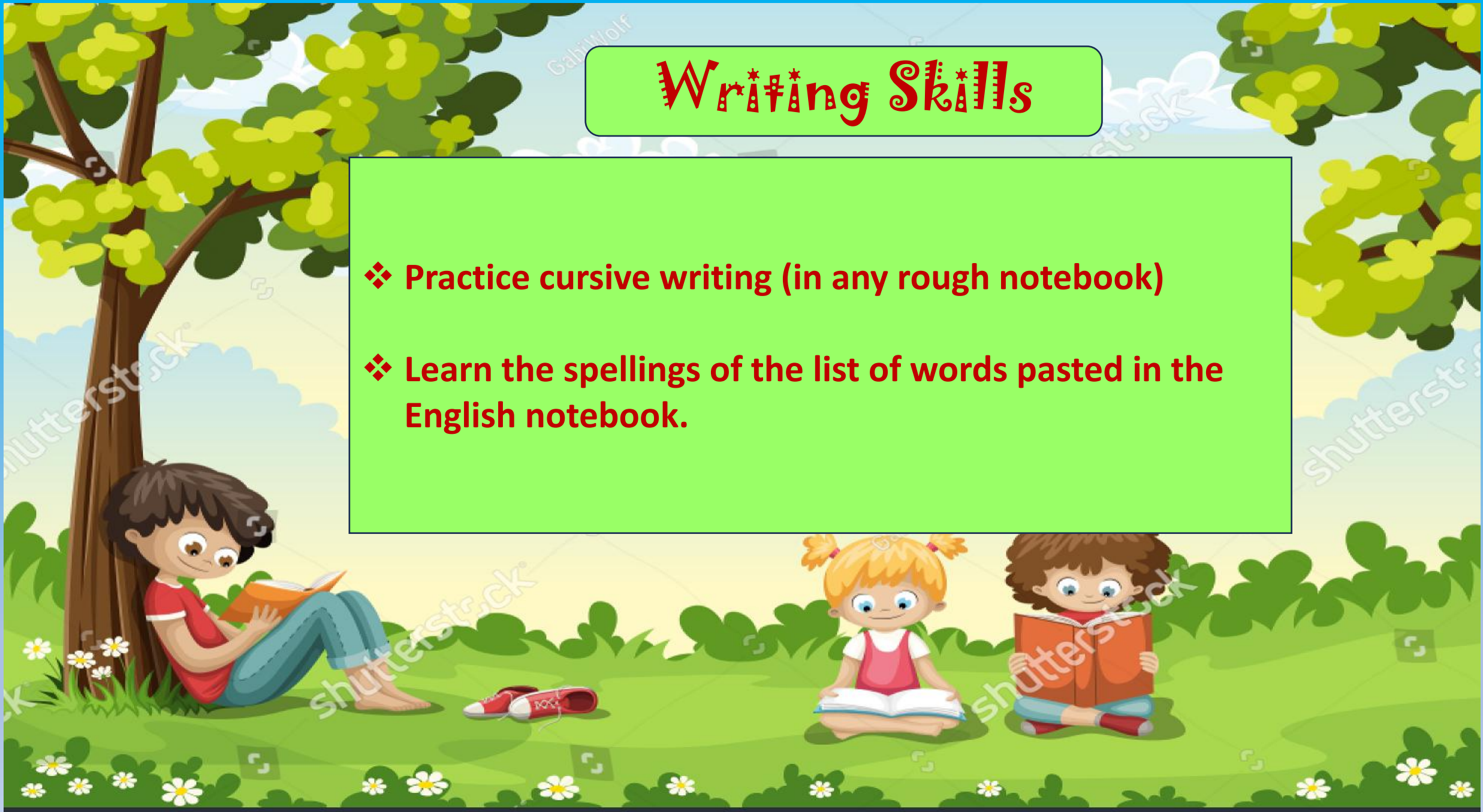

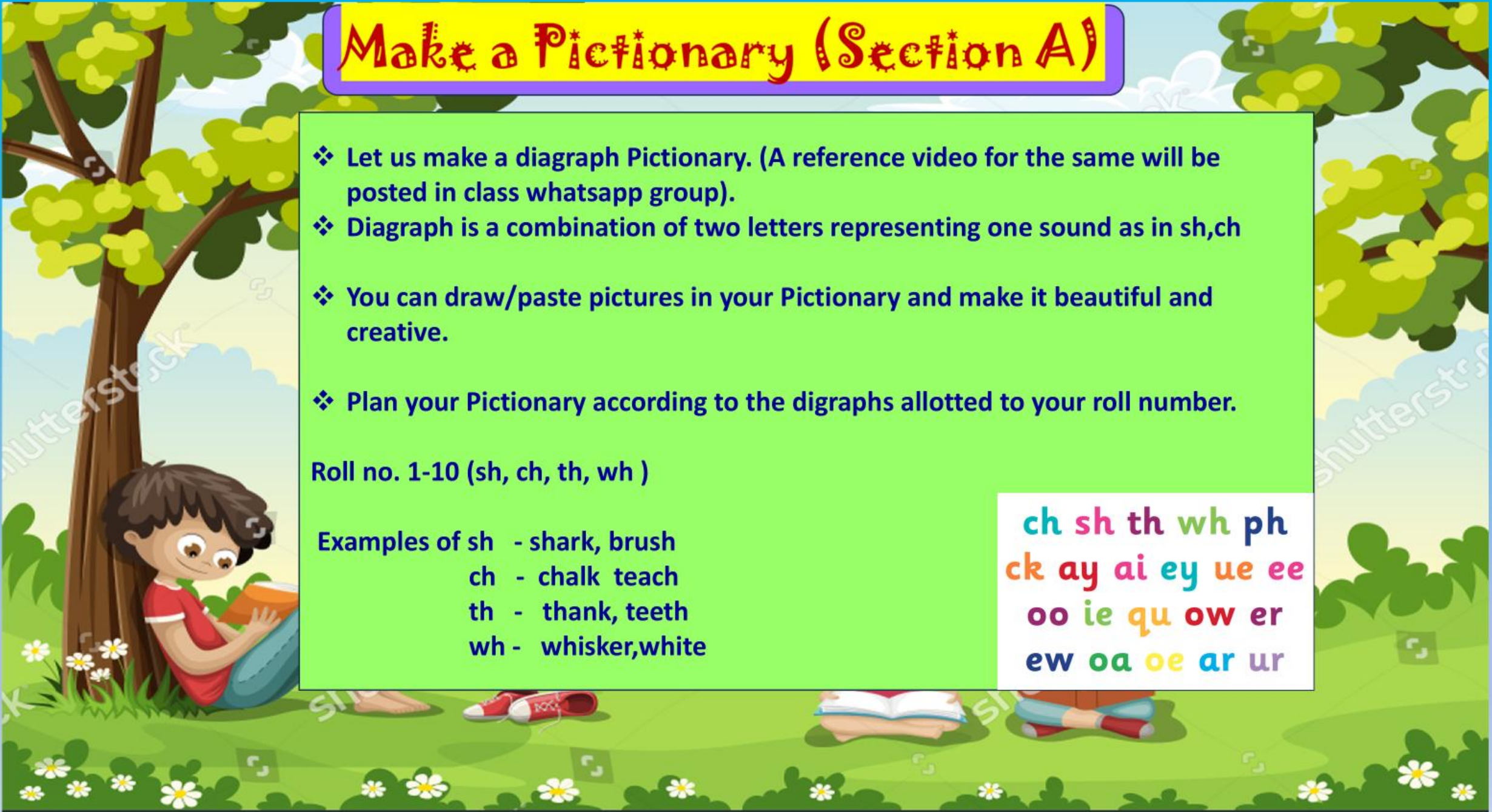
Make a Pictionary (Section A)
