



Assignment Instructions:

- 1. Make a festival calendar booklet on anA4 size sheet: Divide A4 size sheet into three equal parts. Staple the sheets together after making the booklet.
- Create a colorful monthly calendar (either hand-drawn or digital).
- Mark at least 1 major Indian festival in each month (you can include regional festivals too).
- For each festival, write:
 - Name of the festival
 - Religion or region it belongs to
 - One line about its significance

- 1. Place Cotton in the Cup:
- Fill the bottom of the cup with moist cotton or tissue.
- 2. Add Seeds:
- Place 2–3 seeds on top of the cotton, so they are clearly visible from outside the cup.
- 3. Water Gently:
- Sprinkle a little water on the cotton to keep it moist (not soaked).
- 4. Place in Sunlight:
- Keep the cup near a window where it gets some sunlight every day.
- 5. Watch and Record:
- Every day, check your seeds.
- 6. Bring the growing seed in the cup.

or other tiny plants into the soil.

4. Add Water:

Pour a little water into the bottle to moisten the soil (don't make it soggy).

- 5. Add Tiny Creatures (Optional): You can add a worm or an ant if you wish, but this is optional.
- 6. Close the Lid:

Seal the bottle with its cap or lid. This helps make it a closed ecosystem, like a mini-world.

7. Place in Sunlight:

Keep the bottle near a window where it gets light, but not direct hot sun.
