Instructions to <u>create your outfit with</u> <u>tessellation pattern:</u>


• Sketch your dream dress on a cardboard sheet (size A3 o A4), capturing

- Label your work with your Name,






Number Maze


- Solve the maze step by step.

- Tables make repeated addition easy.


Magic Number Grid Challenge!
